We should have good behaviours all the times. We should be nice to pupils in the classroom, library and the playground.

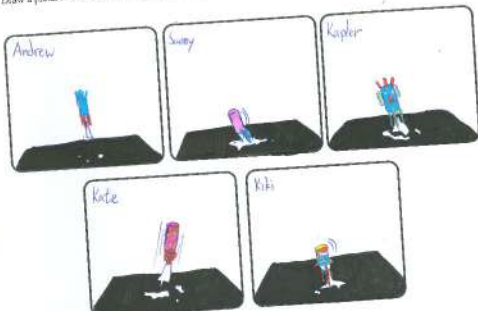

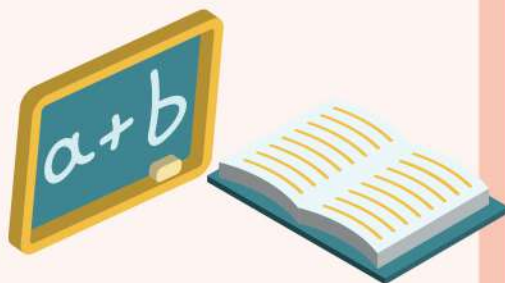
